How Many Dinosaurs is Too Many?

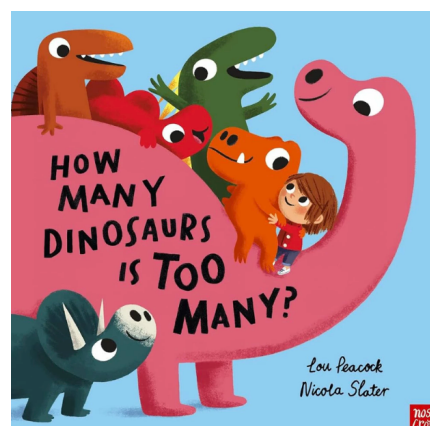
